CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HOWARD SAXTON

of Star Route, Gales Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Gales Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21411 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 17, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Parson DLC #37, Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.3 acres in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Omri Parson DLC #37
1.5 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Omri Parson DLC #37
Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W.M.
0.3 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Omri Parson DLC #50
1.4 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Omri Parson DLC #50
Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beg. at a point on the township line between T 2 N, R 4 W, & T 2 N, R 5 W, W.M. Washington Co., Ore. N 0° 03' E 897.2 ft from the cor. of T 1 & 2 N & 4 & 5 W thence N 0° 03' E 174.1 ft to a 4"x4" cedar stake th. N 78° 0' W 945.5 ft thence S 49° 57' W 69.9 ft to a point in the center of Gales Cr. th. following down center of said Gales Cr. with meandering in southerly direction to a point which is N 6° 15' W 134.3 ft from an iron in center of county rd., th. S 6° 15' E 134.3 th. S 70° 11' E 489 ft; th. S 84° 19' E 489.3 ft, thence S. 60° 43' E 231.5 ft thence N 1° 02' E 1221.5 ft. thence N 89° 37' W 1433.0 ft to the place of beg. containing 44.34 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
