## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

FRED C. MEYER

of 233 S. 9th Avenue, Hillsboro , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Meyer's Pond constructed under Application No. R-26962, Permit No. R-1356 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation, supplemental under Permit No. 21306 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 9.0 acre feet

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE_{+}^{1}NE_{+}^{1}$ . Section 15. Township 1 South. Range 3 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per-second per acre, a diversion of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet (per acre) or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 9.0 acre feet per year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.0 acres in the NE4NE4
5.4 acres in the SE4NE4
Section 15
Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
