of Route 4, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Tualatin River, to be appropriated under Application No. 23695, Permit No. 19431,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1030 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 5, 1949,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 30.0 acre-feet.
