## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GERALD I. HERB

, has made proof of Route 2. Forest Grove , State of Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek & Drainage Ditch & reservoir constructed under Application No. R-25488, Permit No. R-1302 for the purpose of a tributary of

irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters 20969 under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW+NW+ & SW+NW+, Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1302, water to be diverted from drainage ditch when available and any deficiency in the available supply in the drainage ditch is to be made up by diversion from West Fork Dairy Creek, providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed and shall 1/80th c.f.s. for each acre irrigated, conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 10.7 acres in the WanwinEt 30.0 acres in the NETNWH 30.0 acres in the NWANWA Section 12 Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
