This Is to Certify, That CITY OF RAINIER

of Rainier, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Fox Creek, tributary of Columbia River, to be appropriated under Application No. 26759, Permit No. 21029,

municipal supply for the purposes of

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1319 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 3, 1952,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed $14\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet.

The ^{dam}reservoir is located in Section 28 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Tp. 7 N., R. 2 W., W. M.
