of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 17779 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31. 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.73 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4SE4, Section 25, NW4NW4, Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 32 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 21.4 acres in the SEESE Section 25

33.6 acres in the NEINE

7.8 acres in the NW4NE4 20.6 acres in the NEINWI

10.2 acres in the NWiNWi

Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
