CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE E. OLSON

of 525 NW 123rd Ave., Portland 1, State of Oregon 97229, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cedar Mill Creek

tributary of Beaverton Creek for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 18973 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 9, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4, as projected within Josiah Hall DLC #53, Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.7 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Josiah Hall DLC #53
  - 0.3 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Josiah Hall DLC #53
- Section 34  
Township 1 North, Range 1 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beg. at an iron pipe in the place on the N line of the Josiah Hall DLC #53, T 1 N, R 1 W, W.M., which iron pipe marks the most Easterly cor. of that certain 8.12 acre tract of land conveyed to A. W. & Margaret A. Stephens by deed recorded at page 43 of Volume 108 of Wash. County, Oregon, Record of Deeds, & running th. S 47° 17' W along the S E/ly line of the said Stephens tract 461.7 ft. to an iron in place; th. N. 7° 03' W 314.6 ft. to a point on the N line of the said Hall Claim; th. N 89° 50' E along said claim line, being also the N line of the said Stephens tract, 377.8 ft. to the place of beg., containing 1.355 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
