has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 9, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the Swisse. as projected within Josiah Hall DLC #53. Section 34. Township 1 North. Range 1 West. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightlath of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
