This is to Certify, That B. F. SMITH	
of R.F.D. Ontario , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the	
nuters of waste and drainage ditch of the . Adribution Nyssa-Arcadia Drainage District , for the purpose of the irrigation of 60 acres of land,	
domestic use under Permit No. 3695 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered	
of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume - 1 ,	
nt page 320, on the 15th day of May, 1919; that the priority of	
the right hereby confirmed dates from September 19, 1917; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.65 cubic feet per second.	
A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarterand 20 acres in the North half of Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty, Township Nineteen South, Range Forty-seven East of Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon.	,
The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Office	
The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, us herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
