of Aumsville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed pond formed by springs and stream a tributary of for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20027 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right nereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1950; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NELSEL, as projected within Niel DLC #42, Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

20.8 acres in the NE₄SE₄, as projected within Niel DLC #42 4.2 acres in the SE₄SE₄, as projected within Niel DLC #42 Section 18

Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M.
Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
Beg. at a point 80 rods E of the SW cor of the DLC of Alexander Neil, being Claim #42,
T 9 S. R 1 W. W.M., Marion County, Oregon; running th. E 48.16 rods; th. N 80.0 rods,
th. W 48.16 rods; th. S 80.0 rods to the place o. beg. Also, commencing at the
NE cor. of the above described premises and running th. N. to the right-of-way of
the Benham Ditch Co.; th. W/ly along the S line of said right-of-way to the center
of the County Rd leading from Stayton to W Stayton, Oregon; th. W/ly along the
center of said rd. to a point due N of the NW cor. of the above described premises;
th. Southwesterly along the center of said rd. to a point which is about 5 rods
W of said NW cor.; th. E/ly to said NW cor.; th. E to the place of beg. & containing in all 32.7 acres of land, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
