CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)
This is to Certify, That WOLF RUN WATER USERS ASSOCIATION
of Dufur , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the and Eight Mile Creek waters of Tamarack Creek, Springs and Gulch, a tributury of Columbia River
, for the purpose of the irrigation of 20 acres of land,
domestic and stock use under Permit No.s 92 & 93of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered
of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1
nt page 320 , on the 15th day of May, 1919 ; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dutes from 193, 1909 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 0.35 cubic feet per second.
A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to heneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Five and 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Two South, Range Twelve East of Willamette Meridian, in Wasco County, Oregon. Ch.P.L. p. Div. Sp. Or. Vol. 12, p. 152
The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eights of one cubic foot per sec: for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of retation; balance for domestic and stock use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.
The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
