This Is to Certify, That A. G. & M. K. HORTON

of 4150 S.W. Childs Rd., Oswego , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 21092 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SENN, Section 20. Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres in the SE4NW4 Section 20 Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

ft. S & 1041.95 ft. W of the \$\frac{1}{2}\$ sec. cor. on the N boundary of Sec. 20, T 2 S,
R 1 E, W.M., & running th. W tracing the N boundary of the F. W. Wanker & Eliza
Wanker tract aforesaid 319.35 ft. to an iron pipe; th. at right angles S 1407.70
ft. to a point in the meander line of the left bank of the Tualatin River; th.
following the meanders of the left bank of the Tualatin River down stream N
840 07' E 321.04 ft; th. N 1374.80 ft. to a place of beg., in the County of
