CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That M. W. KNICKERBOCKER, c/o DeArmond & Erskine  
of Bend State of Oregon 97701 has a right to the use of  
the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of the Deschutes River

for the purpose of irrigation and domestic use. (Irrigation during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 120 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.14 subic feet per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 27 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; and 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, T 15 S. R. 11 E. W.M., in Crook County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supercede that certain certificate issued to Josephine Stockley on November 29, 1911, and recorded in Vol.1 at page 300 of State Record of Water Right certificates, and on page 108 in Vol.1. Water Certificates for Crook County, wherein 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section, township and range was erroneously omitted from the original certificate)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
