CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That STATE OF OREGON BOARD OF FORESTRY
of 2600 State Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed stream
a tributary of Walker Creek for the purpose of
domestic use in forest camp
under Permit No. 16002 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 27, 1944
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the $N\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 5 North, Range
7 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2,
Township 5 North, Range 7 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at the center of Section 2, T 5 N, R 7 W, W.M., which is marked by a steel
automobile axle; th. N 30° E 1320.0 ft.; th. E 745.8' to the W right of way line
of the Beneke Creek road; th. S 17° 30' W 1070.5 ft. along said right of way line;
th. S 7° E 301.6 ft., continuing along said right of way line, th. W 449.0 ft.
to the point of beg., being that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T 5 N, R 7 W,
W.M., lying W of the Beneke Creek road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
