CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BEN BURLEIGH

of Timber, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring a tributary of Gales Creek for the purpose of domestic use 1 family under Permit No. 22197 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
Township 2 North, Range 5 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beg. at an iron pipe in place on the N line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26, T 2 N, R 5 W, W.M., which pipe is also on the W boundary of the Wilson River State Highway R/W, & same pipe bearing S 88° 51' W a distance of 1114.2 ft. from the NE cor. of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 26, & running th. S 88° 51' W along this N line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26 a distance of 102.2 ft. to an iron pipe on the E boundary of the Gales Creek & Wilson River R.R. R/W; th. S 00° 36' W along this E boundary of railroad R/W a distance of 221.5 ft. to an iron pipe; th. S 86° 00' E a distance of 110.3 ft. to an iron pipe on the W boundary of the Wilson River State Highway R/W; th. N/ly around a spiral curve to the left, along this W highway boundary, to the place of beg., the long chord of this last course bearing N 1° 22' W a distance of 231.4 ft. This tract contains 0.55 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
