## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. V. SNIDER & MRS. A. M. SNIDER

of Route 1. Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22711 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 4, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE SE, Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.8 acres in the NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>
6.2 acres in the NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
Commencing at the \( \frac{1}{4} \) sec. cor. on the E side line of Sec. 12, T 2 S, R 2 W, W.M., & running th. W 20 chs.; th. N about 7.55 chs. to the SE cor. of a tract of land conveyed by R. M. Jesperson & wife to William Hurds; th. W along the S line of the said William Hurds said land about 25 chs. to the center of the county road; th. S/ly along the center line of said road about 19.50 chs. to an angle post in said road; th. S 40° E 12 chs. to the Tualatin River; th. down said stream to the E line of said Sec. 12 & th. N along said E sideline of Sec. 12. to the place of beg., being 16 chs. more or less & containing 90 acres more or less situate in the DLC of E. H. Harer and wife in said County and State.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
