CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. C. & EMELIA B. KNODELL

of 808 Washington St., Albany, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Alsea River domestic use for 1 family, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn & garden under Permit No. 22786 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW1/4SW1/4), Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 5 (SW1/4SW1/4)
Section 27
Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at the Meander cor. between Secs. 27 & 28, T 13 S, R 10 W, W.M., said point being on the N bank of the Alsea River running th. N 37° 45' W along the bank of river 134.4' th. S 85° 15' E 240.6'; th. S 5° 30' W 360', to the bank of Alsea River; th. NW/ly along bank of Alsea River to place of beg., containing 1.4 acres more or less, together with right of way for water pipe line and except right of way for power line.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
