CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of domestic use in Austin Hwy. Maintenance Hdqts. & Blue Mt. Ranger Station under Permit No. 23709 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 22, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 12 South, Range 35 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 11 South, Range 35 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
