CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
 c/o Forest Supervisor
 of P.O. Box 1272, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Rock Creek
 a tributary of Middle Fork of the Willamette River for the purpose of
 Black Canyon Forest Camp
 under Permit No. 22854 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from March 9, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.15 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 27, Township 20 South,
 Range 2 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
 per acre,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 8 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Lot 7 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Lot 7 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Section 27
 Township 20 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
