## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Pawder River , a tributary of Powder River , for the purpose of the irrigation of 90 acres of land under Permit No. 3142 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume ut puge , on the 28th day of 329 July, 1919 · i; thut the eviority of the right hereby confirmed dates fromOctober 24, 1916 : that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesuid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 1.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall not form on the proper State Officer. Its and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 25 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirteen: 35 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 30 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fourteen, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willemette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
