## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That HAROLD I. BEESON

of 6790 Silverton Rd., Salem , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Pudding River

a tributary of Pudding River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 22366 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 21. 1953.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE SE SE as projected within Howell DIC #47. Section 4, Township 7 South. Range 2 West. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected within Howell DLC #47 Section 4 Township 7 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 347.32 ft. N. 51° 04° E. from the SW cor. of the
John Howell DIC #47, in T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; thence N. 64° 36° 30° E., along
the Northerly line of the New Silverton Highway, 246.36 ft.; thence N. 22° 30° 30°
W., 315.35 ft.; thence S. 64° 36° 30° W. 327.73 ft. to the Easterly line of Land
Conveyed to Nellie Howe; thence along said Easterly lines 42° 23° E. 75.13 ft.
to an angle point in said line and S. 35° 38° E. 246.70 ft. to the point of
beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
