CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (For rights perfected under original or secondary permits.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That GRANT MAYS AND HAROLD BALDWIN, of Prineville,

State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of

Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River, a tributary of

Deschutes River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 467 acres of land under Enlargement Permit No. 39 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, on Page 329, on the 28th day of July, 1919; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1909; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.84 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.
