## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

State of Oregon Rt. 2, Aurora , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream & reservoir constructed under Appl. #R-25299. Per. #R-1134 a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters 20210 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE NW . Section 34, Township 3 South, Range 1 West. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1134,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.5 acres in the NE NW 30.8 acres in the NW NW Section 34 Township 3 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
