CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (For rights perfected under original or secondary permits)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That MT VERNON IRRIGATION AND POWER COMPANY, of Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

and Beach Creek, a tributary of John Day River, for the purposes of the irrigation of 490 acres of land, and domestic use, under Enlargement Permit No. 88 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at Page 329, on the 28th day of July, 1919; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 6, 1911; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually, beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.23 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 15 acres in the SE1SE1; 20 acres in the SW1SE1; 15 acres in the SE1SV1; 5 acres in the SW2SW1; of Section 23; 7 acres in the SW2SW2; 15 acres in the SW2SW2; 20 acres in the SW2SW2 of Section 22: 8 acres in the SE1SE1; 20 acres in the SW1SE1; 24 acres in the NW1SE1 of Section 21: 40 acres in the SW1SW2; of Section 20: 2 acres in the NW1W2; 25 acres in the SW1NW2; 38 acres in the NW1NW2; 5 acres in the SW1NW2; 25 acres in the NE1NW2; 38 acres in the NW2NW2; 5 acres in the ME1NW2; 10 acres in the SW2NW2; 35 acres in the SE1NW2; 17 acres in the NE1NW2; 10 acres in the NW1NW2; of Section 28 and 10 acres in the NW2NW2; of Section 27, all in Township Thirteen South, R ange Thirty East of Willamette Meridian, in Grant County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is retricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference tight of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
