CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** W. T. McCLAUGHERY

of Rt. 1, Monroe, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hammer Creek a tributary of Marys River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20693 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 28, 1951,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  both as projected within Hammer DLC #48, Section 26, Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Hammer DLC #48  
3.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Hammer DLC #48  
13.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Hammer DLC #48  
3.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Hammer DLC #48  
Section 26  
Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe, which is 15.389 chs. N. 89° 58' E. of the SE corner of the Hawley DLC #50, thence S. 11° E. 17.681 chs. to the N. side of the P.E. & E. R.R. r/w; thence S. 89° 46' E. 780 chs. along the N. side of said r/w; thence N. 11° W. 17.713 chs. to the N. line of Claim #48; thence S. 89° 58' W. 6.780 chs. to the place of beginning. Beginning at a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe which is 1.079 chs. N. 89° 58' E. of the SE corner of the Hawley DLC #50, thence N. 89° 56' E. 14.310 chs.; thence S. 0° 11' E. 17.682 chs. to the N. side of the P.E. & E. RR r/w; thence N. 89° 46' W. along the N. side of said r/w; thence N. 0° 11' W. 17.616 chs. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
