**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** MELVIN SHORT, THE OAKS RANCH  
of Amazon Oil Company  
of 3108 W. 11th. Street, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Parker Creek and Elk Creek  
a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of  
irrigation  
under Permit No. 20109 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from February 13, 1951.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.42 cubic foot per second, being 0.30 cubic foot per second from Elk Creek and  
0.12 cubic foot per second from Parker Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$   $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8 and  $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17,  
both as projected within Daisley DLC #37; Township 22 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

From Parker Creek  
6.8 acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$   $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Daisley DLC #37  
Section 8  
2.6 acres in the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Daisley DLC #37  
Section 17

From Elk Creek  
3.2 acres in Lot 5 ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
2.4 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Daisley DLC #37  
16.8 acres in the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Daisley DLC #37  
0.7 acres in Lot 4 ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
0.4 acres in Lot 3 ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
0.3 acres in the  $SW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Daisley DLC #37  
0.4 acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 17

Township 22 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
