of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 334 , on the 27th day of September, 1919 ; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from August 7, 1916; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: The Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Two, Township Twenty-six South, Range Thirteen West of Willamette Meridian, in Coos County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
