CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILMER MOORE

of Rt. 1, Stanfield, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring and seepage a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 10 acres under Permit No. 20388 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 18, 1951, for 0.25 cubic foot per second & July 1, 1952, for 0.25 cubic foot per second, ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.285 cubic foot per second from spring and 0.215 cubic foot per second from seepage,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M. from the spring and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W.M. from seepage.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-twentieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12
Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Secs. 12 & 13, T. 4 N., R. 28 E.; running thence N. 33 ft. to the point of beginning of this description being on the Northerly right of way line of the County Rd. #867; thence N. along the N. & S. center line of Sec. 12, a distance of 430 ft., more or less, to its intersection with the Southerly right of way line of the U.S.R.S. "A" line canal; thence Easterly along the Southerly right of way line of said "A" canal a distance of 860 ft.; thence Southeasterly at right angles to County Rd. #867 a distance of 540 ft. to a point on the Northerly right of way line of said County Rd. #867; thence Westerly along said Northerly right of way line to the point of beginning. EXCEPTING: therefrom lands described in Warranty Deed Book 192, Page 109 of Deed Records of Umatilla Co., Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
