a tributary of South Umpqua River Riddle Smelter (supplemental fire protection, domestic, milling & smelting ore.) 21987 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby November 28, 1951, confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.4 cubic feet per second, the amount of water to be diverted hereunder together with that amount available from Rail Gulch under the certificate of water right recorded in Volume 17, Page 24239, State Record of Water Right Certificates shall be limited to a total diversion from both sources of not to exceed 3.4 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 NW4, Section 33. Township 30 South, Range 6 West. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
