CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
 Mark H. Astrup, Landscape Engineer
 of State Highway Building, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 an unnamed spring
 a tributary of Middle Fork John Day River for the purpose of
 roadside drinking fountain
 under Permit No. 22874 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from March 31, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 8 South, Range 31
 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
 per acre,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 31
 Township 8 South, Range 31 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is part of that described as follows:

A parking area lying between the traveled roadway and a line parallel to and
 35 ft. northerly of the center line of the Pendleton-John Day Highway, extending
 easterly from engineer's centerline Station 641+50 to Station 645+00, the center-
 line of said Highway being described as follows: Beginning at said Station
 641+50, said Station being 408 ft. S. and 187 ft. W. of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, more or
 less, and running thence S. 69° 30' E. 242.3 ft.; thence on a 9° curve to the
 left 107.7 ft. to said Station 645+00.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
