CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. F. JACKSON

of Rt. 1, Box 67-L, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Collins Gulch, tributary of Pleasant Creek, appropriated under Application No. 29922, Permit No. 23553.

for the purposes of
irrigation and supplemental irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1742 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1955.

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 1.00 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 21, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Tp. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.
