CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. F. JACKSON

of Rt. 1, Box 67-L, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Jackson Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-29921, Permit No. R-1742 a tributary of Pleasant Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 8.3 acres under Permit No. 23553 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1955.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 acre feet stored water,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second~~ a diversion of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre feet per year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22
Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
