CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **REX and ETHEL CLEMENS**

of P. O. Box 327, Philomath, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Luckiamute River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 118.5 acres under Permit No. 20809 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 12, 1951.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.48 cubic feet per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Robbins DLC #49 and Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 18, Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

 2.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willoughby DLC #48
 4.6 acres Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 17.9 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Robbins DLC #49
 5.9 acres Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 9.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willoughby DLC #48
 23.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willoughby DLC #48
 0.1 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Robbins DLC #49
 0.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willoughby DLC #48
 2.1 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willoughby DLC #48
