CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HUGH H. and HELEN D. DRUMMONDS

of Rt. 1. Box 476, Veneta , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Tom River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 3.0 acres

under Permit No. 21953 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 21. 1952.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres $SW_4^1 NW_4^1$ Section 21 Township 17 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point in center of road N. 1172 ft. from the SE corner of the SW-NV-1 of Sec. 21, T. 17 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; thence S. 200 ft. along center line of road; thence W. 915 ft., more or less to center of Long Tom River; thence along center line of Long Tom River in a Northerly direction to a point W. 849 ft. more or less of point of beginning; thence E. 849 ft., more or less to point of beginning, all in Lane County, Oregon

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
