CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL and NINA PECK

of Box 92, Maupin, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Davidson Spring a tributary of White River for the purpose of domestic use 36 families and manufacturing under Permit No. 24543 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 6, 1956,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second, being 0.20 cubic foot per second for manufacturing and 0.05 cubic foot per second for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

manufacturing NE 1/4 SW 1/4
manufacturing and domestic use 17 families SE 1/4 SW 1/4
manufacturing and domestic use 19 families NW 1/4 SE 1/4
manufacturing SW 1/4 SE 1/4
