**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** P. E. MEEKER

of P. O. Box 39, Amity, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Harrison Lake a tributary of South Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.5 acres under Permit No. 24693 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1957,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within W. A. Culberson DLC #70, Section 25, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within W. A. Culberson DLC #70  
Section 25  
Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe which is S. 785.7 ft. and W. 1034.1 ft. from the NE corner of Culberson DLC #70 and running thence N. 18° 29' E. 488.3 ft. to an iron pipe; thence W. approximately 20 ft. to a point in Harrison Lake which is 6.0 ft. beyond the low water line, thence Southwesterly with the meanders of said Lake and 6.0 ft. from the low water line to a point which bears N. 79° 52' W. from the point of beginning, thence S. 79° 52' E. approximately 60 ft. to a pipe set on the bank as witness to the true corner, thence S. 79° 52' E. 269.8 ft. to a point of beginning, containing 1.75 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
