## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. H. and GLADYS C. HOYT

of 107 S. 1st Street, Silverton State of Cregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Indian Creek and Fall River

a tributary of Deschutes River

for the purpose of

domestic use Fall River Lodge and Trailer Park, and power 14061 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 17, 1939.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.52 cubic feet per second, being 0.02 cubic foot per second from Fall River for domestic and 1.5 cubic feet per second from Indian Creek for power.

To the contact throughters of Basic or its equivalent in case of rotation. The point of diversion is located in the NWL SWL, SWL SWL, Section 31. Township 20 South; Range 10 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to- - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Section 31 Township 20 South, Range 10 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municing thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all approxenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the vater rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality hall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, us may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
