CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That PAT. BARRY,

of Heppner, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of BALM FORK, tributary to Willow Creek, tributary to the Columbia River, in Morrow County, Oregon,

for the purpose of irrigation, (during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1885 for the irrigation of eight (8) acres and from 1904 for the irrigation of nine and eighteen hundredths (9.18) acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic feet per second as of date 1885 and 0.15 cubic feet per second as of date 1904.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Four and seventy-eight-hundredths (4.78) acres in SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; seventy-seven hundredths (0.77) acres in SE 1/4 of SW 1/4; Sec. 35; Tp. 2 S. R. 26 E., W. M.; ninety-six hundredths (0.96) acres in NW 1/4 of NE 1/4; six and eight-hundredths (6.08) acres in NE 1/4 of NW 1/4; four and forty-nine-hundredths (4.49) acres in SE 1/4 of NW 1/4; one-tenth (0.1) acre in SW 1/4 of NE 1/4; Sec. 2, Tp. 3 S. R. 26 E., W. M., in Morrow County, Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
