**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** FORREST MARTIN

of Route 2, Box 270-G, Dallas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-30126, Per. No. R-1743 a tributary of Rickreall Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres under Permit No. 23561 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 11, 1955.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Nichols DLC #70, Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1743,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 30

All as projected within Nichols DLC #70  
Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

beg. at a point marked with an iron pipe in the center of the County Road leading from Ellendale to Dallas, said point being on the W. boundary of the B.F. Nichols DLC at a point 72 chs. N. of the SW corner of said claim No. 70, Notl. No. 1950, in T. 7 S., R. 5 W.; th. running N. 81° E. 1.76 chs. to a pipe driven in the ground; th. N. 89° E. along the center of the County Road, 6.53 chs.; th. N. 14 chs.; th. W. 8.40 chs. to the W. line of the Nichols Claim; th. S. 14.5 chs. more or less to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
