**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** RUSSELL D. MESSER.

of Box 825, Brookings, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream a tributary of Chetco River for the purpose of domestic use in a repair shop under Permit No. 22621 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 3, 1953,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 5, Township 41, South, Range 13 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 6 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Section 5  
 Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at a point on the Easterly right of way boundary of U. S. Highway 101, said point being N. 1928.8 ft. and W. 1668.4 ft. from the Sec. corner common to Secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, said T. & R.; th. N. 50° 00' E. 137.8 ft.; th. S. 47° 17' E. 53.5 ft.; th. S. 42° 43' W. 140.7 ft., more or less to a point on the Easterly right of way boundary of U. S. Highway 101; th. following said highway boundary N. 44° 02' W. 71.2 ft., more or less to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
