CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That S. O. and CORINNE K. NEWHOUSE

of Wedderburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Eva Miller Creek a tributary of Edson Creek (Rogue River) for the purpose of domestic use 1 family under Permit No. 23066 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at an iron pipe driven on the Westerly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway at a point 360.3 ft. N. and 2258.7 ft. W. of the SE corner of Section 8; th. S. 86° 45' W. 678.7 ft. to an iron pipe; th. N. 21° 6' W. 449.3 ft. to an iron pipe; th. N. 26° 58' E. 110.6 ft.; th. N. 38° 4' E. 98.0 ft.; th. N. 54° 52' E. 134.9 ft.; th. N. 7° 38' E. 119.8 ft.; th. N. 14° 10' E. 97.4 ft. to an iron pipe driven on the Westerly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway right-of-way. Thence South-easterly, following the Westerly boundary of said highway right-of-way to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
