CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

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of Heppner, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of BALM FORK, tributary to Willow Creek, tributary to the Columbia River, in Morrow County, Oregon,

for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use; (irrigation from March 20th to October 20th of each year)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1873 for the irrigation of ten (10) acres and from 1908 for the irrigation of six (6) acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic feet per second as of date 1873 and 0.1 cubic feet per second as of date 1908.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Two (2) acres in NE_4^1 of SW_4^2 ; six (6) acres in SW_4^2 of SE_4^2 ; nine (9) acres in SE_4^2 of SE_4^2 ; Sec. 19; Tp. 3 S. R. 27 E., W. M., in Morrow County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
