CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That M. T. BAKER  
of Pilot Rock State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of East Birch Spring, NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, T 1 S R 32 E. W. M.,  
tributary of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 18 1/2 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of  
Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,  
in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at  
page 127 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1870 for  
13 acres and 1907 for 5 1/2 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the  
purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-  
poses, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions  
of paragraph 33 of said decree, and all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water  
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water  
is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 2 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest  
quarter; 6 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 10 acres in the  
Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township One  
South, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Ch. Pt. of Div. of 10<sup>2</sup> acres  
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The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the  
lands or place of use herein described.
