CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SOPHRONIA BLACK

of Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Beech Creek
for the purpose of Stock and Power for development of 2.3 horsepower

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1871

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per

second, for Power and the quantity fixed by Paragraph 108 of the State Engineer's Findings and Order of Determination as confirmed by Decree of the Circuit Court, for Stock

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of Use: Beginning at a point 395 ft. west of the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 13 S., R. 30 E., thence South 110 ft.; thence East 70 ft.; thence South 140 ft.; thence West 293.42 ft.; thence North 205.92 ft.; and thence East 199 ft. to place of beginning and known as the Black Residence Lot in Mt. Vernon, Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
