CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SELMA C. BROWN

of Canyon City, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Brewery Spring
for the purpose of Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the quantity fixed by Paragraph 108 of the State Engineer's Findings and Order of Determination as confirmed by Decree of the Circuit Court.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of Use: SW¹SE¹, Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M.
described as: An undivided one-half interest in and to Lots 10 and 11, in the town of Canyon City, Oregon, in accordance with the plat of said town, recorded at pages 176 and 177, Volume "N", Records of Deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
