CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That GEO. W. BUSH (J.A.Guderian, present owner) of Pendleton State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Birch Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 35 1/2 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 7, at page 127 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1889.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree, and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 11 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 18 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter, and 1 acre in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-two; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 1/2 acre in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen, Township One North, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

WITNESS the seal and signature of the State Water Board of Oregon affixed this 29th day of December, 1919.
