CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That SOPHIE BYERS,
of Pendleton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Umatilla River, a tributary of the Columbia River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 29.4 acres of land, domestic and stock use and
milling

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of
Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,
in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at
page 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1895 for ir-
rigation purposes and 1870 for milling purposes,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the
purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-
poses, and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions
of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained
in said decree; and shall not exceed 167 cubic feet per second for milling purposes.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water
is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 17.6 acres in the Northeast quarter of North-
east quarter; 4.6 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter, and 7.2
acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twelve, Township
Two North, Range Thirty Two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County.

The place of use for milling purposes is at the Flouring Mill in the City
of Pendleton, County of Umatilla.

lands or place of use herein described.
