CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That. CITY OF CONDON, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

of Condon, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Hay Creek for the purpose of Municipal

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Used in City of Condon. All of Section 10 T. 4 S., R. 21 E., W. M., except SW1/4

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
