A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.0 acres in NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)Section 5,
10.2 acres in NE\(\frac{1}{2}\)Section 6,
T. 11 S., R. 34 E., W. M.

Middle Fork John Day River: 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month; total of five acre-feet per season, measured at point of diversion.

lough:
1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per
second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month
to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured
at point of diversion.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
