and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilia County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Record of the Record of the Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 17 at page 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1906 for 5 acres and 1908 for 21 acres,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount netually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 13 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of North, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
